A HOPE AND A FUTURE

This past December was a turning point for two of our residents and their own personal walks with God. Connie and Sara both decided to be baptized. Both young women shared stories of despair, without hope, strength nor faith in God nor themselves. I have seen both girls grow in tremendous ways since coming to Well of GRACE.

Sara wanted a relationship with God so bad that I wanted to fight right along side her to get her there. She struggled with God to get to a point where she knew that she could have complete faith in Him and know that He did not leave her side. Slowly, I saw a change in her. God started working! Here was a girl who was never comfortable praying and soon, she was praying for dinner and praying for our staff. She found God again and learned how to put her trust in Him. She made the choice to be baptized and to commit herself fully to God! She had faith in herself and more importantly—faith in Him again!

Connie always seemed to know that there was a God out there watching and waiting for her to come to Him. She shared about her life and the trials that she faced growing up and having to deal with the repercussions of a horrific accident that left her feeling hopeless and alone. During her time at Well

of GRACE Connie realized how much God loved her and He had kept her alive for a reason. One Sunday Pastor Colp from First Church of God spoke about life and the paths God has you on. It was a great message and the next day,

he shared about a woman in the service who came up to him and shared about her life and wanted to give her life completely to Christ. That woman was Connie! She realized that God did indeed pull her through her hardest moments because of how much He loved her!

When Connie and Sara chose to be baptized, they wanted to know if they could do it together. The event was truly a memorable one. With a few close friends, Well of GRACE staff and board members in attendance, I watched these two once battered,

broken and lost women become God’s children and my sisters. It was an amazing thing and to be a part of their transformations was an honor for me. I have since talked to each of them and they still have strug-

gles, but they both strive to live for Christ and lean on Him. I stand firm on Jeremiah 29:11 that God will keep His promises to Sara and Connie, our current and future residents, and our staff.



Connie's story

I am very proud to graduate from Well of GRACE Ministries. Just a few short months ago all my thoughts about myself and life in general were negative.

One of my assignments was to read *God Has A Dream For Your Life* by Sheila Walsh. The book uses the characters from the Wizard of Oz to illustrate its points.

I wanted life to be perfect as Dorothy did. I avoided emotions similar to the Tin Man. I was ignorant to life around me like the Scarecrow, and I was cowardly like the Lion because it was the easier and the softer way. However, all these characters sought to change, but I was content living in the misery and blaming past circumstances and others for my problems.

Today, I know different. Today, I know that I cannot dwell in that past life. I can move on and feel good about myself because I let go and let God into my life. By opening up my soul to God and accepting His love I now understand that even though life will bring me challenges, God's strength and love will enable me to face these challenges in a healthy manner.
